



EOI / Announcement – Joint Surf Rescue Certificate and Bronze Medallion course February and March 2022

Dear future Tacking Point member,

Tacking Point SLSC will run a joint Surf Rescue Certificate (SRC) and Bronze Medallion (BM) course in the months of February and March 2022.

The course is a combination of:

- Online eLearning and assessments
- Classroom theory and dry practical learning
- Wet practical sessions on the beach and in the surf
- A dry assessment and a wet assessment

The course requires a reasonable level of physical fitness and requires good swimming skills. It is recommended that prospective participants note the pool swim requirements and practice ahead of the proficiency date.

Those completing the course commit to joining a Tacking Point SLSC patrol and agree to patrolling as active members of the Club (about a half day every 3 weeks).

Course plan

Induction to Assessment is 5 weeks for SRC, 8 weeks for BM .

- SRC is 10 Sessions: one weekday evening and one 2-3 hour session either Saturday or Sunday.
- BM is 17 sessions : one weekday evening and one 2-3 hour session either Saturday or Sunday.

Tacking Point Surf Life Saving Club

Prerequisites Surf Rescue Certificate

- Aged minimum 13 on 3 March 2022.
- Evidence of complete COVID-19 vaccination.
- Successfully complete the proficiency pool swim of 200m in less than 5 minutes.

Costs

\$90 as a contribution to the costs of the course.

Prerequisites Bronze Medallion

- Aged minimum 15 on 24 March 2022.
- Evidence of complete COVID-19 vaccination.
- Successfully complete the proficiency pool swim of 400m in less than 9 minutes.
- Either prior to the course or during the course participants need to complete a first aid course: Provide First Aid (HLTAID011).

Costs

\$125 as a contribution to the costs of the course, not including the cost of the first aid course (\$50-70).
